


GB GENERAL PURPOSE DIGGING BUCKET




This bucket, the design basis for other styles, is ideally suited for general construction applications with common digging material including soil, dirt and gravel.



HB HEAVY DUTY DIGGING BUCKET





The heavy duty bucket features the same design as the general purpose one, but has been adapted to demanding excavating applications.

Connect

Safety knuckle in safe positionready to engage. Buzzer is sounding 1 beep per second because the wedge is retracted.



Safety knuckle engages automatically onto front pin, securing the attachment immediately.



Self-adjusting wedge locks second pin as soon as lock switch is deactivated.



Disconnect




Unlock self-adjusting wedge and disengage coupler from the back pin. Buzzer is sounding 1 beep per second.



Unlock safety knuckle with the switch - buzzer is sounding at 2 beeps a second as the safety knuckle is retracted.




Coupler can be removed from attachment. Buzzer shows that coupler is still open.



After 5 to 10 seconds the safety knuckle re-engages to the safe position.




